# SITE EMERGENCY INSTRUCTIONS

In the case of an emergency requiring evacuation of the worksite, being either a fire, earthquake, serious accident, bomb threat, structural collapse, tsunami, explosion, aviation accident, hazardous spill or practice evacuation - the following warning will sound: **THREE LONG BLASTS ON A HORN – REPEATED TWICE** 

#### Location of Fire Extinguishers

An extinguisher is located in site offices

Location of First Aid Kits First aid kits are located in site offices

#### Designated Assembly Areas

Waiteika Road Quarry, Opunake - front of smoko room, Waiteika Road entrance Whenuku Road, Hawera – top of hill at entrance Nukumaru Station Road, Maxwell – main entrance gate

## FIRE

- If you discover a fire **raise** the alarm
- Ensure the fire service is notified. Dial 111
- Clearly state the nature of the emergency and the location
  - South Taranaki Quarry Corner of Waiteika and Eltham Road, Opunake
  - South Taranaki Quarry 278 Whenuku Road, Hawera (gate directly off the end of the road)
  - South Taranaki Quarry Nukumaru Station Road, Maxwell
- If possible extinguish the fire but <u>only</u> if you can do so safely

## **ACCIDENT / INJURY**

- Administer first aid or provide assistance
- Seek medical attention as soon as possible if necessary
- In the event of a serious accident or injury ensure the ambulance service is notified. Dial 111
- Clearly state the nature of the emergency and the location
  - South Taranaki Quarry Corner of Waiteika and Eltham Road, Opunake
  - South Taranaki Quarry 278 Whenuku Road, Hawera (gate directly off the end of the road)
  - South Taranaki Quarry Nukumaru Station Road, Maxwell
- Do not move any unconscious/seriously injured people unless they are in immediate danger of further injury

# **QUARRY OPERATIONS**

#### TRUCK DRIVERS HAZARD AWARENESS - DO'S AND DON'T'S

- **DO** give way to all quarry machinery
- DO ask where to go for loading
- DO wear safety boots
- **DO** wear hard hats and hi-vis vests
- DO stay in the cab while being loaded
- DO park where instructed by loader
- DO check your load
- DON'T speed in the quarry or approaches 15km speed limit
- DON'T leave your cab while being loaded
- DON'T stop behind loader
- DON'T park near crusher or screens
- DON'T let passengers out of truck
- DON'T go near quarry face

#### TRUCK DRIVERS - BEFORE YOU LEAVE THE QUARRY, PLEASE ENSURE THAT:

- Your load is the correct product
- Your load is the correct quantity
- Your load is positioned correctly
- Your tailgate(s) is/are secure

#### REMEMBER THE LOAD IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY – PLEASE WATCH FOR OTHER TRAFFIC

## SUMMARY OF THE BASIC SAFETY RULES

- All accidents and near misses must be reported to the Site Manager
- Protective safety equipment appropriate to the environment must be worn at all times
- Enter and exit Whenuku Road via Ketemarae Road
- Do not exceed 50km per hour along Whenuku Road
- Slow to a maximum of 30km per hour for pedestrians, cyclists and children along Whenuku Road
- Do not use engine brakes; in, out, or along Whenuku Road
- All light vehicles give way to heavy vehicles
- No unauthorised visitors
- Drivers are to ensure load security and complete a final check
- Upon arrival wait in a safe open area for an operator to come to you
- Be aware of all high faces, open ponds, moving machinery and loose stockpiles
- Do not approach machinery until an operator has indicated to do so
- Know the location of our nearest fire extinguisher
- No alcohol or drugs allowed
- Be aware of evacuations and emergency procedures in our workplace
- If unsure ASK!
